




The Spirit's Invitation: Come!



Pentecost in Jewish Calendar



- 🔥 **Pentecost** (*Gk, Pentēkostē or 50 days after Passover*)
- 🔥 **Festival of Harvest** (*"firstfruits of the wheat harvest."*)
- 🔥 **Festival of Weeks** (*Shavuot, after 7 weeks*)
- 🔥 **Festival of Grains**

The angel answered, “**The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you.** So the Holy One to be born will be called the Son of God.






Matthew 3:16 (NKJV)


Acts 3:3-6 (NIV)


Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah.


25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

As a body without breath is a corpse, so the church without the Spirit is dead.
