


Luke 2: 9-11 NLT

REJOICE

Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice'
(Philippians 4:4).

BENEFITS OF REJOICING IN THE LORD



1 Peter 1:3 All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by His great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead.

Now we live with great expectation,

we have been given new birth into a living hope

⁴ and we have a priceless inheritance—an inheritance that is kept in heaven for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay.

we have an inheritance that is pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay. (imperishable, uncorrupted, unfading, and kept in heaven)

1 Peter 1

⁵ And through your faith, God is protecting you by His power until you receive this salvation, which is ready to be revealed on the last day for all to see.

we are protected by God's power through faith for a salvation that is ready to be revealed

⁶ So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you must endure many trials for a little while.

we rejoice in all of this even if we are currently struggling through some trials

1 Peter 1

These trials will show that your faith is genuine.

It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold—
though your faith is far more precious than mere gold.

So when your faith remains strong through many trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when Jesus Christ is revealed to the whole world.

as we continue to rejoice through our trials, the genuineness of our faith results in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus

1 Peter 1

⁸ You love Him even though you have never seen Him. Though you do not see Him now, you trust Him; and you rejoice with a glorious, inexpressible joy.

we love Him even though we haven't seen Him

We believe in Him and rejoice with inexpressible joy

⁹ The reward for trusting Him will be the salvation of your souls.

we are receiving the reward for trusting Him *(goal of our faith)* – the salvation of our souls

We rejoice in the Lord despite our circumstances because rejoicing in God means that ...

- we take delight in Him and not our circumstances.
- we are comforted by His name and His presence.
- despite what I am going through, I know that I am loved, cared for, and watched over.

JOY - long-lasting state of being.

Joy - promised by God; we should strive towards...

Hebrews 12:2 "For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

- joy in the eternal life that continues even after death.

The constant knowledge of our salvation and God's love for us will undoubtedly give us joy, even if our present circumstances aren't ideal or we aren't presently "happy."

so much JOY ahead for us.

Romans 14:17-- "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit."

there will be joy in heaven, we can have joy now in our expectant waiting. God promises us joy when He promises salvation.

- keep this truth in our minds, we can find peace and joy even in our earthly suffering.

1. Christ is Lord

Philippians 2:11 ... every tongue acknowledge JESUS IS LORD

2. Christ has Accomplished Salvation

Philippians 2: 6-8

⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to His own advantage;

⁷ rather, He made Himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to death - even death on a cross!

WHY REJOICE? 3. Christ gives Us His Righteousness

Philippians 3: 9....and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith.

4. Christ Enters an Amazing Relationship with Us

Philippians 3:10 I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of His resurrection and participation in His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death....

5. Christ Provides Us with a Great Future

Phil 3:20 But our citizenship is in heaven.

And we eagerly await a Savior from there,
the Lord Jesus Christ...

The best is yet to be - hell-deserving but heavenly rejoicing

6. Christ Brings Us into a Wonderful Family

Philippians 4:1 Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!...

7. Christ Takes Away All Our worries

Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

the Joy of Christmas 8. Christ gives peace



Phil 4:7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

9. Christ gives victory

Phil 4:13 I can do all this through Him who gives me strength.

10. Christ supplies all our needs

Phil 4:19 And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus.

"HAPPINESS" and "JOY" interchangeable?

Happiness and joy seemingly similar, actually quite different. God promises joy, but He never promises us happiness.

Being happy is an EMOTION,

like sadness or jealousy or fear; fleeting. can be happy about something, but not going to be continually happy forever.

Happiness is great -- we can get happiness from a lot of things, even earthly things.



God gives us JOY, ...even if we are not happy.

No need to smile all the time.



We're not promised sunshine and rainbows in this life, but we are promised salvation and eternal life, which is cause for great joy

even in the midst of pain, fears, doubts and unhappiness.





James 1:2-4 ESV

- ² Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds,
- ³ for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.
- ⁴ And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing



John 16:22 So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you.

²³ In that day you will ask nothing of Me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in My name, He will give it to you.

²⁴ Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive,

that your joy may be full.




