S.O.A.P is a simple method for reading and applying God's word to our lives. By SOAPing your verses you are able to dig deeper into scripture and "see" more than if you simply read the verses. Let me encourage you, children to take the time to S.O.A.P. the daily verses and see for yourself how much more you get out of your daily reading.....you'll be amazed.

S.O.A.P involves four simple steps.



SCRIPTURES

Read a short Bible passage out loud and/or write it out.



OBSERVATION

- What do you notice about the verses?
- What do you think the main message is?
- What verses, words or ideas jump out at you?

APPLICATION



Ask God how He wants you to apply the verse to your own life.

Pray for yourself and/or for others.

The most important ingredients in the S.O.A.P. method is **YOUR interaction** with God's Word and **YOUR APPLICATION** of His Word for YOUR life.
