- Proclaim the Gospel (Proclamation and Demonstration)





- Teach us how to pray (v.1-4)
- Pray with confidence, boldness (persistence) because of relationship (v.5-8)
- Ask, seek and knock (v.9-12)
 (Matthew cf good gifts, Luke cf Holy Spirit)
