1. DOES AS TOLD
2. LED BY THE ROLE
3. DUTY DRIVEN
4. EXCLUDED FROM THE MASTER'S WORLD 
5. TAUGHT WHAT TO DO

## **THE FRIEND**

1. DESIRES TO OBEY
2. LED BY IDENTITY
3. RELATIONSHIP DRIVEN
4. INCLUDED INTO THE MASTER'S WORLD
5. SHOWN WHAT TO DO AND WHY

***John 15:8-17*** (NASB)

<sup>8</sup> My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples.

<sup>9</sup> Just as the Father has loved Me, I also have loved you; remain in My love.

<sup>10</sup> If you keep My commandments, you will remain in My love; just as I have kept My Father's commandments and remain in His love.

<sup>11</sup> These things I have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and *that* your joy may be made full.

## ***John 15:8-17 (NASB)***

**12** “This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

**13** Greater love has no one than this, that a person will lay down his life for his friends.

**14** You are My friends if you do what I command you.

**15** No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, because all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

***John 15:8-17*** (NASB)

<sup>16</sup> You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

<sup>17</sup> This I command you, that you love one another.

## **1 John 2:15-17** (NASB)

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

<sup>16</sup> For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world.

<sup>17</sup> The world is passing away and *also* its lusts; but the one who does the will of God continues *to live* forever
