

- Love and care and in SSMC, "grateful"


## 1. Longevity – The Facts

- Human Development Index of UNDP, 0.643 in 1990 to 0.81 in 2019 (The STAR, 8 Sept 2023)




#### **MEDIAN AGE BY COUNTRY 1950**

The Seasons of Life Ecclesiastes 3:1-2,11 <sup>1</sup> To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven:

<sup>2</sup> A time to be born, And a time to die; A time to plant, And a time to pluck *what is* planted;

<sup>11</sup> He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.

#### 3. Multigenerational Church : Today vs Yesterday

- 6 generations under one church roof silent gen, boomers, X, Y, Z, Alpha
- Language Gen Y & Z : YOLO, FOMO, TNTL vs Baby Boomers : groovy, hippie, like, boogie
- Technology : punch cards vs smart phones, multitasking vs sequential tasking (Bill Gates, Steve Jobs)
- Competency vs lived experience, speed vs stability
- Mental health vs paced life

#### 3. Multigenerational Church - Challenges

- Postmodernism and the Young, a consumerist society like Starbucks
- Separation of services (Sat/Sun worship services, weekends, free flow vs liturgical, etc)
- Virtual church and virtual seminars/training church without borders and f2f, attendance?
- Physical dependency & frailties


### 3. Multigenerational Church – Luke 2: 41-50

- Feast of the Passover, a 12-year old boy left behind
- Assumed in the company of friends and relatives
- After more than 3 days, found in a temple at Jerusalem
- Engaging in deep listening and conversation with teachers/elders, age is no barrier
- "My Father's business"

### 4. Being Intergenerational

#### 4.1 Listening & Trust

- Tim Elmoe on what can stop us listening well 1) Judgmental 2) Selective 3) Impatient
  - 4) Egocontric 5) Detronicing 6) Stubbor
  - 4) Egocentric 5) Patronising 6) Stubborn
- Listening with the "ear to the heart"
- Trust deficit amongst the young (Global Youth Trust)
- Trust begins when relationships are nurtured
- Dr Chansamone's father, paternal and maternal grandfather from Hinduism to Christianity – a testimony of trust and conversion
