

Christians in **Sabah** and **Sarawak** constitute **71%** of the Church in Malaysia











Ephesians 1-3

- We are complete in Christ.



1. A Prayer for Inner Strength (Vs. 16)


¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,



Rocky Heart

Enthusiastic at first to God's Word, Rocky Heart shallow & lacks will to strengthen initial gift.

Heart

Heart partially commits to Christ, leaving disastrous vulnerability to worldly desires & concerns.


Rebellious Remaining Heart

Heart fully dedicated to Jesus is firmly established, reaping fruit of righteousness plentifully.
