PASTORAL MESSAGE

Dear SSMC Family,

Greetings in Jesus' name!

Thank you for your faithful endurance and perseverance in using Being With Jesus! I trust that God's Word has been effectively working in our lives and producing in us a Christlike character and lifestyle. As a church, we thank Pastor Ng Swee Ming for establishing BWJ to bring the church into reading the Word of God together, cover to cover, with the desire that our faith must be founded on the solid rock of God's Word. We continue with his legacy as we enter our 6th year of Being With Jesus.

Come 2022, life is gradually returning to "normal" from the Covid-19 pandemic. Everyone and everything had been shaken and tested in different ways for the past 2 years. Covid-19 has not ended as it is now endemic. Today, the world we live in is a different place. We must adapt and continue to live meaningful and productive lives. My personal view is that Covid-19 will not be the first and last global disruptive event. It is a foretaste and wake-up call for us, the church, to RESET, REFRAME, RECOMMIT and REDEPLOY as a faith community belonging to the LORD Jesus Christ. Things cannot and must not be business as usual.

The church must pivot not to greater heights of sophistication or modernity but to coming back to basics. Christ Jesus has left a template for us. We progress and experience renewal through rediscovery and experiencing again what coming to faith is, what following Jesus entails and what is our mission and purpose, and how the simple and profound message "Jesus Christ is LORD" sums up and affects us individually and corporately, affects our neighbours, this nation and the entire creation as it is worked out in a relational, contextual and relevant setting today.

A good resource to refer to is www.biblehub.com

The Word of God is not INFORMATIONAL but FORMATIONAL. It must teach/ educate our HEAD, convict and transform our HEART, and move our HAND. Let's encourage and hold each other accountable as this is a loving thing to do, to live and share the Word.

Read the Word with God's Story as context to help us make sense of how each specific story is synthesised and woven into one unified big story. Often, we "miss the forest for the trees". Hold both the 'big story' and 'small story' in tension as we do BWJ.

As we do this, the Word must equip us for God's mission (***Missio Dei***).

We want to affirm again that SSMC is an inter-generational church. We need each other to leverage on the collective wisdom and strength of the generations from 'fathers and mothers' to 'young men and women' and 'children'. The leadership team and their spouses are here to serve as servants, for we are one of and one with you. Let's journey together on this adventure.

INTRODUCTION TO PSALMS

The Hebrew title for Psalms is “Tehillim”, meaning “songs of praise”.

The Psalms is a collection of 5 Books:

Book 1: Chapters 1–41

Book 2: Chapters 42–72

Book 3: Chapters 73–89

Book 4: Chapters 90–106

Book 5: Chapters 107–150

Psalms is not a random collection of ancient poems. There is an overarching narrative of a faithful God who hears all who cry out to Him in praise or pain, wisdom or confusion, confidence or doubt. The anthology (collection of Psalms):

1. Is a story of God’s movement in Israel’s past and also future promises where all of creation is headed, when we will dwell with God, He with us forever.
2. These are the expressions of the honest, brutal, authentic heart cries to God because He is transcendent and immanent (present and personal). The types include wisdom (Psalms 1), lament (Psalms 22), praise/ liturgical (Psalms 100), and royal psalms* (Psalms 2).
3. Book 1 (1–41) and 2 (42–72) are psalms attributed to King David, the man after God’s heart expressing his joys and blessings, pain and troubles. And through David’s words, we discover that we too are invited to be honest with God and that there’s nothing too big or too small to bring before Him.
4. Book 3 (73–89) and 4 (90–106) of Psalms follow the theme of the crumbling kingdom and include a collection of prayers Israel prayed while exiled to Babylon. These prayers provide a template for our lives when everything appears to fall apart or not going well. Psalms 106 ends with a plea to God to gather Israel from the nations.

5. Book 5 (107–150) celebrates the faithful God who rescued Israel. It begins with news of God answering the prayer (Psalms 106). These psalms speak of God's steadfastness, faithfulness and unending love to His own. This collection of literature examines the Israelites' return from exile, the "Aliyah" (going up) psalms or the Songs of Ascent, that ultimately points forward to the day when Jesus would come and begin the process of fixing our broken world.

When reading the Psalms, hold two positions clearly. First, God's big story (meta-narrative), the ultimate redemption of Israel and all creation. Second, the personal human stories at play that adds up collectively to make the big story (meta-narrative is the synthesis and combination of many narratives).

Note:

* Royal psalms relate to subject matters of kingship with reference to King David and /or the Lord Jesus. The latter, from an eschatological and messianic perspective.

QUESTIONS TO ASK

1. Who is the author?
2. Is there a context to the particular psalm?
3. Can you identify if it is a wisdom, lament, praise/ liturgical or royal psalm?
4. What is the MAIN message?
5. What does it reveal about God or Jesus?
6. What does it reveal about man?
7. How does that apply to me?
8. What will I do about it?
9. Who am I going to share this with?

If there are more than one psalm allocated for the day, please feel free to choose only one for deeper reflection.

GUIDELINES TO READING PSALMS

Sample READING

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: **Psalms 2**

<i>Context</i>	Royal psalm with messianic overtone (immediate and future). A psalm about the Lord and His anointed (King David and King Jesus).
<i>Main idea</i>	The Lord reigns. His anointed is King. All opposition from nations, people, kings and rulers of the earth fail ultimately. The King will rule in all and over all i.e. Eph 1:20–23.
<i>God's Character</i>	The Lord is Sovereign. None above and before Him.
<i>Man's Character</i>	Man can plot and oppose/ rebel to break free from the reign of God and His anointed (v.3) but will not prevail.
<i>Application</i> (Promises / Warning)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A psalm about King David as the anointed of the Lord. A foreshadow of King Jesus, the anointed One. 2. A decree (the Lord's, v.7) is not a promise but an order with the full force of law i.e. as good as done! 3. Jesus is LORD. He rules over all nations, even to the ends of the earth in the fullness of time (v.11). Hallelujah! <p>This is how we should pray, declare and worship. The conclusion of the God's Big Story. Give me this captivating vision of what will be!</p>

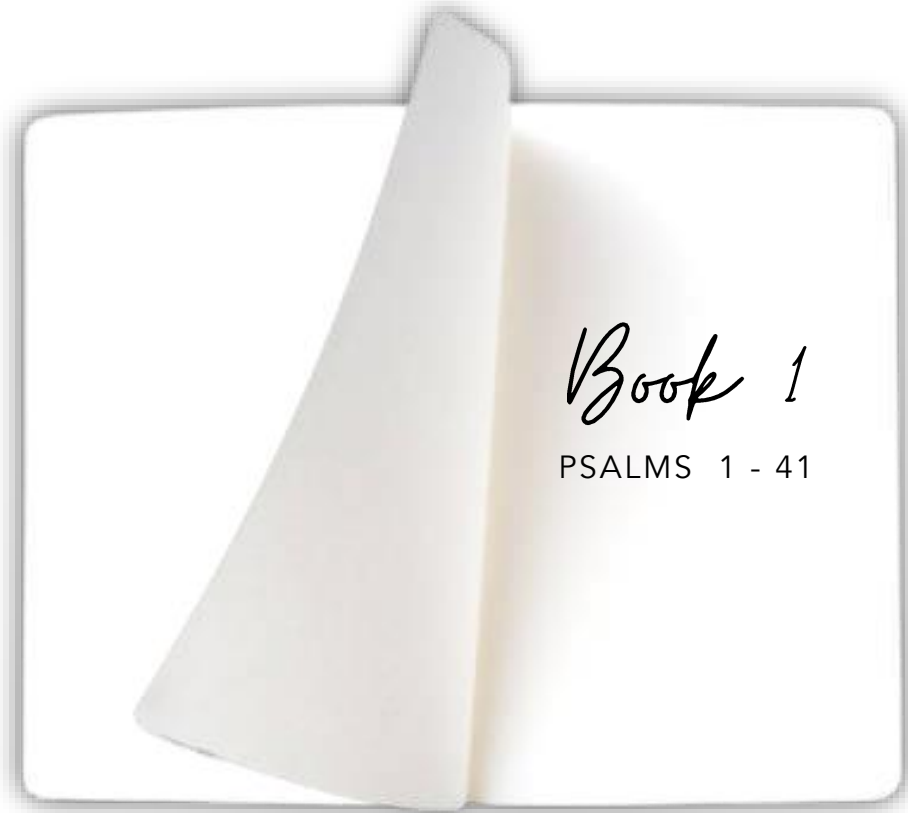

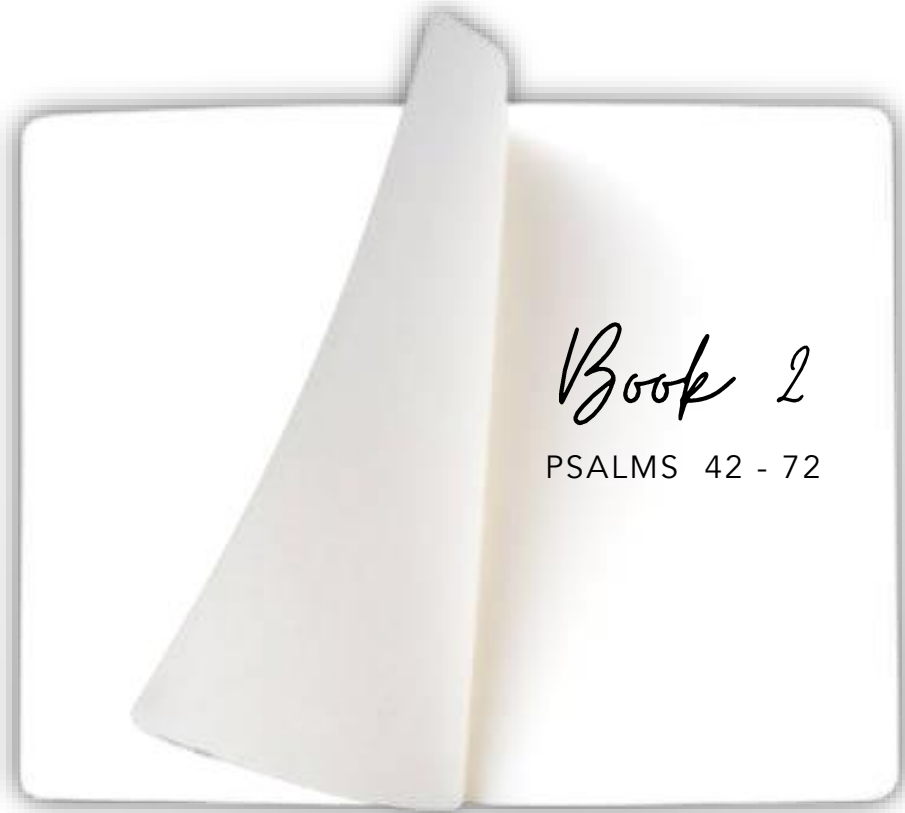

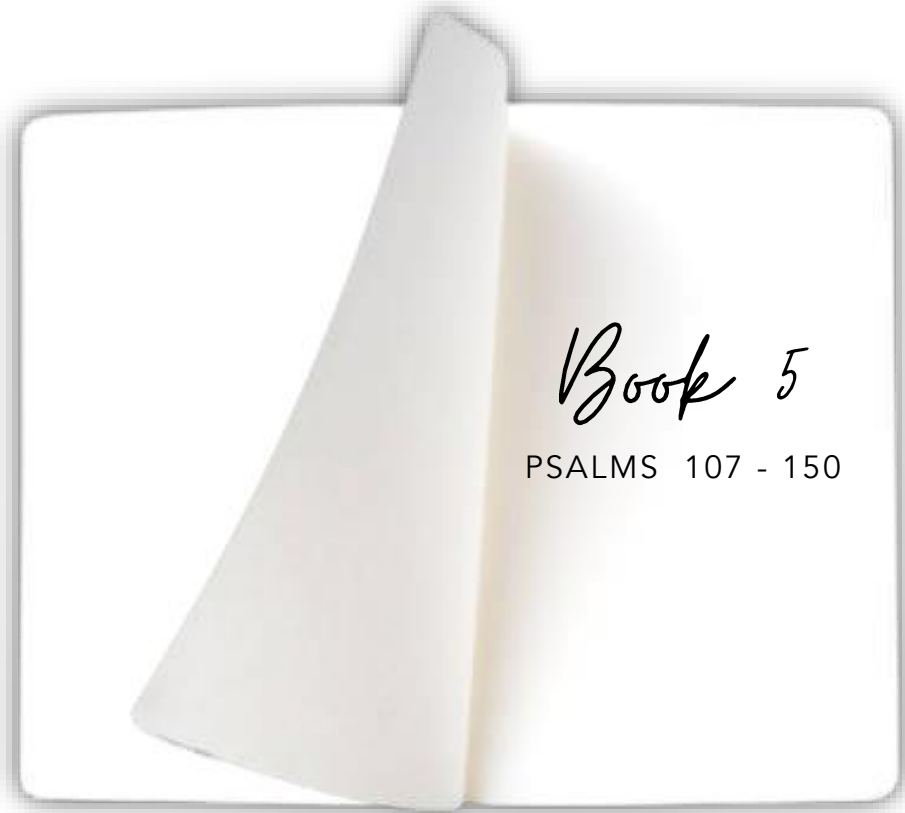
