The Power of JOY

<u>John 20:19-20 (</u>NIV)

¹⁹ On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁰ After He said this, He showed them His hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

Proverbs 24:10 (NIV)

If you falter in a time of trouble, how small is your strength!

John 20:21-22 (NIV)

²¹ Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent Me, l am sending you." ²² And with that He breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

- 1. Jesus came, spoke, showed
- 2. Disciples saw the Lord, were overjoyed
- 3. Trinity of the Father, Son (Jesus) and the Holy Spirit

JESUS:

- restores, renews, rebuilds
- strengthens the relationship and the joy in Him

The Power of FAITH



But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in His hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

John 20:26-27 (NIV)

²⁶ A week later His disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see My hands. Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Stop doubting and believe."

THE POWER OF FAITH

1. Jesus - came, spoke, ask Thomas to touch

- 2. **Stop** doubting and believe (a command)
- 3. Thomas confessed who Jesus was "My Lord and my God" (v28)
- 4. Jesus came just for Thomas (1 person)

JESUS:

- restores, renews, rebuilds
- strengthens the relationship and faith in Him

CAN MAN DEPEND ON **HIS STRENGTH ALONE?** My profession My area of expertise My years of experience My self-confidence and self-assurance **Unacceptable:** Mistakes, failure, falling short of expectations...

GOD MAY ALLOW IT TO HAPPEN, SO THAT WE MAY...

- Be humble
- Not be boastful
- Rely on HIM
- Not rely on own ability & cleverness
 - **Experience HIM**
 - Return to HIM

THE POWER OF LOVE **OVERCOMES YOUR...** Hopelessness Frustrations Helplessness Anger Exhaustion Disappointments Sense of defeat Loneliness

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy;

I have come that they might have life, and have it to the full.

John 10:10 (NIV)



THE POWER OF LOVE
Jesus's gentleness, thoughtfulness
"Come and eat" - Jesus prepared for them

Used His nail-pierced hand to give the bread and fish to them

So what did Jesus really do? Jesus redirect their focus back to HIMSELF Christ Jesus, not on disciples' failures.

CONCLUSION: <u>NEW LIFE, NEW LIVING</u>

1st appearance - The Power of JOY restored. - Faith and hope in Christ Jesus 2nd appearance - The Power of FAITH restored. - Not a single one was left out 3nd appearance - The Power of LOVE restored. The disciples experienced it and were recommissioned.

Ephesians 1:17-19 (NIV) ¹⁷ I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know Him better. 18 | pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and His incomparably great power for us who believe.

Ephesians 3:16-19 (NIV) ¹⁶ I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.
